
- 1) Utilize IRA Conservation Funding to Rebuild America's Soil
- 2) Conservation Adjustments: Support Regenerate America's Proposals for a Regenerative Transition
- 3) Research Improvements: Prioritize Soil Health Agriculture Research and Education
- 4) Credit Reforms: Pass the DEFER Act
- 5) Rebuild the Missing Middle: Advance Regional Infrastructure, Processing and Markets
- 6) Common Sense Crop Insurance: Remove Barriers and Reduce Risk
